I also understand that I am only authorized to access those student education records in which I have a legitimate educational interest as defined in University Policy AD-11, based on the responsibilities and duties of my position as described by my supervisor. Any access to student education records other than those in which I have a legitimate educational interest is a violation of University policy and may constitute just cause for disciplinary action, including termination of my employment and imposition of other disciplinary sanctions.
