New Instructional Modes

Several new course modes go into effect fall semester 2023, and students will see the updated modes when they register for fall courses in LionPATH in spring 2023. Some instructional modes remain unchanged.

NEW OR UPDATED INSTRUCTIONAL MODES

Remote Synchronous (RS) NEW MODE	Class meets remotely at days/times listed. 100% of the class will be taught remotely synchronously. Instructors can offer up to less than 25 percent of a Remote Synchronous class remotely asynchronously.
Remote Asynchronous (RA) NEW MODE, REPLACING WEB (WB)	Class meets remotely. 100% of the class will be taught remotely asynchronously.
Remote Blended (RB) NEW MODE	Remote Blended (RB) Class meets 100% remotely. The class will be intentionally taught remotely combining asynchronous and synchronous (at days/times listed) instruction.
Hybrid 75% and up Remote (H7) UPDATED DEFINITION	Class will meet in person and remotely. 75-99% or more of the class will be taught remotely synchronously or asynchronously.
Hybrid 25%-50% Remote (H2) UPDATED DEFINITION	Class will meet in person and remotely. 25-50% of the class will be taught remotely synchronously or asynchronously.
Hybrid 51%-74% Remote (H5) UPDATED DEFINITION	Class will meet in person and remotely. 51-74% of the class will be taught remotely synchronously or asynchronously.

EXISTING INSTRUCTIONAL MODES—NO CHANGE MADE

In Person (P)	Class meets in person at days/times listed. Instructors can offer up to less than 25 percent of an in-person class remotely (synchronously or asynchronously).
Video-Receiving (VR)	Shared class that a campus receives at days/times listed. 100% of the class will be taught remotely synchronously. Instructors can offer up to less than 25 percent of a remote synchronous class asynchronously. Only for the Digital Learning Cooperative (DLC).
Distance Education (DE)	Used only by the law schools
